



Head of the Negotiating Team for Accession of the Republic of Serbia to the EU, Prof. Dr. Tanja Miscevic, talked today with the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia Ivan Mrkic, following which she held a lecture to the attendants of the MFA Diplomatic Academy.

A lecture titled "Serbia on its path towards EU accession - negotiations" was organized as part of the "Introduction to the EU system and politics" course, falling under the Basic Syllabus of the diplomatic training of the 2013/2014 generation.

The main elements of the accession process, key characteristics and stages of the negotiating process, core institutions and their role were explained on the occasion. The influence and responsibility of public administration, and the necessity of its adaptation, were underlined.
