

First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Ivica Dačić met today with Israel's Deputy Interior Minister Faina Kirshenbaum, who is on a working visit to Serbia.

The officials expressed their satisfaction with the traditionally good and friendly relations between the Republic of Serbia and Israel.
