



First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia Ivica Dacic received today a farewell call by the Ambassador of the Republic of Indonesia to Serbia Samuel Samson.

Mutual interest for further enhancement of political dialogue through exchange of top-level visits and for intensification of all the aspects of bilateral and economic cooperation was expressed in the talks.
