



First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Ivica Dacic received today a courtesy call by the Hungarian Ambassador in Belgrade Attila Pinter.

During the conversation it was noted that the process of steady development in the political dialogue and bilateral relations between Serbia and Hungary was strengthened in the past and a trend of very dynamic meetings between officials of the two countries preserved.
