

First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia Ivica Dacic received the delegation of the Shanghai Institute for International Studies, headed by Director of the Institution's Academic Committee, Yang Jiemian.

At today's meeting, reference was made to the influence of traditional friendship between the two peoples on the overall bilateral relations between the Republic of Serbia and the PR of China, whose development gained a new dimension in the strategic partnership process. They underlined the importance of Serbia's engagement in the mechanism of cooperation between the PR of China and Central and Eastern European countries and the potential of this mechanism in
