



First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia Ivica Dacic assessed that the statement made by Mayor of Srebrenica Camil Durakovic was a disgraceful one.

"The Government of the Republic of Serbia and Prime Minister Aleksandar Vucic have invested great efforts to normalize regional relations and achieve regional stability. Obviously, there are politicians who thrive on conflicts and who do not wish to create a better future, but to deepen past conflicts. No one can teach lessons to Serbia and humiliate it. And will ever anyone, apart from the National Assembly of the Republic of Serbia, condemn the crimes committed against another people? The wish for reconciliation and stability is not our weakness, but rather our strength and an advantage of both Serbia and its Government."
