



First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs estimated that yesterday's decision made by Prime Minister Aleksandar Vucic and President Tomislav Nikolic was an indication of Serbia's wise stately politics.

"This decision upholds both national and state interests of Serbia, as well as the interests of Serbian people of the Republic of Srpska.
