At a moment in time when the whole world is united in sorrow over the loss of lives, we must remain united also in the fight against the evil of terrorism. We must not allow those who spare no means to achieve their ends to threaten all the values which both today's civilization and the better world we aspire to rest upon. Serbia will always stand as ready as ever to defend these values, offering its maximum contribution to the common fight aimed at eradicating this scourge.

May I ask you to convey my sympathies to the bereaved families, and my best wishes to the injured, for their speedy recovery", says the telegram of condolences by Minister Dacic.
