

First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia Ivica Dacic has received today a farewell call from the Ambassador of Slovenia, Mr. Vladimir Gasparic.

Minister Dacic thanked Ambassador Gasparic for an excellent cooperation during his tenure in Belgrade and underlined that Serbia and Slovenia had very friendly relations that reached the highest level in recent history. He also pointed out that the practice of holding joint sessions of the two governments as well as the visits both on high and top levels reflected the dynamic of the bilateral cooperation.
