



First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Ivica Dacic has met today with Minister of Foreign Affairs of Grenada Peter David, at the 73rd UNGA session.

The two collocutors discussed current events on the international political and economic stage.

Minister Dacic informed his counterpart about the course of the dialogue on the status of Kosovo and Metohija, the EU integration process and reforms implemented by the Government of the Republic of Serbia and expressed aspiration of the Republic of Serbia to more strongly engage itself in the political and economic sphere in the developing countries.

Minister David informed the Head of Serbian diplomacy in details about the potential for the development of Granada and their needs regarding the development in the areas of education and agriculture.

The two Ministers concluded that there was a potential for the promotion of cooperation between Serbia and Grenada in many areas of mutual interest.
