

First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia Ivica Dacic received a farewell call from Mr. Phoukhao Phommavongsa, non-resident Ambassador of the Lao People's Democratic Republic to the Republic of Serbia, based at the Embassy of Laos in Austria.
