



First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia Ivica Dacic received today a courtesy call from the newly-appointed Ambassador of the Argentine Republic to the Republic of Serbia, Mr. Estanislao Zawels. It was emphasized in the conversation that Argentina was one of the key partners of the Republic of Serbia in the Latin America region and beyond, that the two countries were tied by years-long bonds of friendship and excellent relations, while sharing in common a commitment to the respect of international law.
