

First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia Ivica Dacic received today a farewell call from the Ambassador of the Federative Republic of Brazil, Ms. Isabel Cristina de Azevedo Heyvaert.

In the talks, gratitude was conveyed for the Ambassador's active engagement and her contribution to the further development of the traditionally friendly Serbia-Brazil relations, while also affirming the interest of Serbia to continue to promote cooperation in all areas of mutual interest with Brazil, one of its key political and economic partners in and beyond the region of Latin America.
