

Ambassador of the Republic of Serbia to Montenegro Zoran Bingulac visited the premises of Matica Srpska (Serbian Cultural Institute) - Association of members in Montenegro, and on that occasion met with the Association President, Dr Drago Perovic and his associates.

The Association representatives briefed the Ambassador on the activities of the organization in Montenegro, which are primarily directed at fostering, developing and promoting the Serbian language and culture. The Association is engaged in scientific research, publishing and archiving, and since its establishment in 2010, it implemented more than a hundred cultural and scientific projects. In addition to literary and scientific discussions, a large number of book launches, exhibitions, film programmes devoted to Serbian cinematography, were organized.
