



The 16th Serbian Film Festival in Australia was formally inaugurated by "A Stinking Fairytale", a film by Miroslav Momcilovic, at "Cinema Paris FOX Studio" in Sydney, on 21 October 2016. During the festival, from 21 October to 8 November 2016, four newest films made by Serbian cineastes will be presented: "A Stinking Fairytale" by Miroslav Momcilovic, "Humidity" by Nikola Ljuca, Double Trouble (Braca po babinoj liniji) by Rados Bajic and "The Black Pin" (Iгла ispod praga) by Ivan Marinovic.
