



In Santa Cruz, the commercial hub of Bolivia, an exhibition "Itinerarium Romanum Serbiae" was formally inaugurated at the Plurinational Cultural Centre. At the opening of this distinguished selection, the attendants were addressed by Director of Cultural Centre Xiomara Zambrana, Ambassador of the Republic of Serbia to Brazil Veljko Lazic and representatives of "Viminacium" Archaeological Park.

The opening ceremony was attended by representatives of local institutions, members of the consular corps, as well as numerous personages from cultural, artistic and academic spheres.
