

Embassy of the Republic of Serbia in Tokyo hosted an exhibition by young women artists from Serbia and Japan entitled "Life and Death – an exhibition of Serbian and Japanese contemporary art". The exhibition, held on the premises of the Embassy from 20-28 April 2017, presented sculptures by and video footage of sculptor Ms. Jovana Tucovic's creative process, as well as photographs by Ms. Akiko Koga.
