

An exhibition of photographs from the "Walking Belgrade" serial by Branko Brandajs, a photographer and artist, presenting the capital of Serbia, was officially inaugurated at the Embassy of the Republic of Serbia in Tokyo. This exhibition was jointly organized by our Embassy and the Association of Artists and Art Lovers of the "Wide Trail" from Zemun, financially supported by the Association for the Advancement of Music Cooperation between Japan and Serbia, headed by the spouse of the former Ambassador of Japan in Belgrade, Mrs. Ecuko Cunozaqi.
