



An exhibition titled "Applied Nostalgia", authored by two artists from Serbia and Estonia capturing on their photographs similar images of the streets of Belgrade and Tallinn, was staged in the lobby of the National Library of Estonia, on 21 September 2017. A photographer from Belgrade, Marko Nikolic, and his Tallinn counterpart, Rait Tuulas, created this artistic project at the initiative and incentive of the Ministry of European Integration of the Republic of Serbia. Each of them photographed street scenes in the counterpart's hometown, seeking motifs reminding them of their own city.

Ambassador Sasa Obradovic thanked the organizers and hosts of the exhibition, which he described as telling of the similarities existing between distant towns and peoples.
