



Japan Serbia Society and Serbian diaspora in Japan had a meeting in the Serbian Embassy in Tokyo, on 29 September 2017, at the initiative of the Society's President Tadashi Nagai, former Ambassador of Japan to Serbia and honorary citizen of Belgrade. This was an opportunity for bringing together Serbian diaspora in Japan and members of the Japan Serbia Society, whose membership has been growing year in year out.
