**Political relations:**

Visits

- Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Estonia Mr. Sven Mikser visited the Republic of Serbia on April 25, 2017
- Former Prime Minister of the Republic of Estonia Mr. Taavi Rõivas visited Belgrade in December, 2014, participating on the Summit PR China – Central and Eastern European Countries (CEEC).
- Former Estonian MFA Marina Kaljurand was Head of the Estonian delegation on OSCE Council of Ministers Meeting in Belgrade, December 3-4, 2015, in Belgrade.

**Economic relations:**

Trade in goods in 2017 amounted to approximately EUR 10,69 million. Foreign-trade exchange between the Republic of Serbia and the Republic of Estonia is modest, with deficit on the Serbian side. In 2015. economic exchange amounted the level of 9,05 million euros, with export 3,97 and import 5,08 million euros. In 2016. export reached the level of 9,92 million euros and import 4,64 million euros (increase of 16,9% in comparison with 2015) and import 5,28 million euros (increase of 4% in comparison with 2015). In first three months of 2017, export amounted 1,158 million euros and import 1,554 million euros.
