The value of trade from January to May 2017 amounted to EUR 17,8 million, out of which exports were EUR 6,2 million and imports EUR 11,6 million. The total value of trade between the Republic of Serbia and Portuguese Republic in 2016, amounted to EUR 35,9 million, out of which exports were EUR 16,2 million and imports EUR 19,7
