Economic relations:

Trade in goods in 2017 amounted to EUR 516,7 million, out of which Serbian exports amounted to EUR 286,9 million, and imports to EUR 229,8 million.

Trade in goods in 2015 amounted to EUR 423.2 million, out of which Serbian exports amounted to EUR 198.5 million, and imports to EUR 224.7 million.
