



At a ceremony held at the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), on 22 May 2013, Prof. Dr. Zavis Janjic, Serbian and American national, living in the USA since 1997, was awarded the international award in the field of meteorological science. He was nominated for the award by Serbian HMI with the support of the U.S. National Weather Service.

This award is the most prestigious award in this field.
