



On 22 June 2016, the Embassy of the Republic of Serbia in Prague, in cooperation with the Bulgarian Cultural Institute and the French Institute, organized the screening of documentary film about Emir Kusturica “Portrait of the Balkan’s Bad Boy” in Prague. The premiere of this documentary, made by the Bulgarian directors Georgi Toshev and Yavor Vesselinov, was opened by the Ambassadors of the Republic of Serbia and Bulgaria in Prague, Vera Mavric and Latchezar Petkov, respectively.
