



Event "Month of Serbian Culture in Hungary" was formally closed at the Embassy of the Republic of Serbia in Budapest in attendance of representatives of Hungarian authorities, the diplomatic corps, Self-Government of Hungarian Serbs' institutions and the media. This year's eighth rendition of the event was organized by the Cultural and Documentation Centre (CDC) of the Hungarian Serbs and sponsored by the Self-Government of Hungarian Serbs.
