



The Consulate of the Republic of Serbia with consular jurisdiction in the territories of Žilinský, Banskobystrický and Trenčiansky self-governing regions was formally inaugurated on 22 January 2018 in the Slovak town of Martin. Honorary Consul Mojmír Vrlík heads the Consulate. Enhancement of economic cooperation, cultural exchange and scientific and technical cooperation will be given priority in the work of the Consulate, in the interest of improving bilateral relations and overall cooperation between the two countries.
