



On 13 January, "Oblate" Library in Florence hosted the presentation of the project "Babylon Bridge – give a book, build a bridge" given by "Start-up Projects" Association, in cooperation with the Embassy of the Republic of Serbia in Rome, Honorary Consul of the Republic of Serbia in Florence and "Singidunum" diaspora association.

The National Library of the Republic of Serbia donated to "Oblate" Library a large number of books in the Serbian language.
