

Ushuaia: Exhibition on Tesla's life and inventions

On Monday 29 October 2018, in Ushuaia, the capital of Tierra del Fuego Province, the Embassy of the Republic of Serbia in Buenos Aires, in cooperation with Nikola Tesla Museum in Belgrade and Telefónica Foundation, organized an exhibition entitled "Nikola Tesla, the Inventor of the 21st Century". This exhibition was special because it was staged on the southernmost populated point of Argentina, at the "House of Culture", under the auspices of the Government of the Tierra del Fuego Province and the Ministry of Education.

This is the fourth edition of the exhibition following three big exhibitions organized in Buenos Aires, Córdoba and Tucumán, in the course of the last two years.
