

Hofu: Exhibitions on Tesla and on Serbian monuments launched

Saturday, 26 January 2019.



An exhibition staged by the Nikola Tesla Museum was formally launched on 26 January in Hofu Science Museum Solar, Yamaguchi Prefecture, at the initiative of the Japan-Serbia Association. Three tons of museum stock have been transported from the Nikola Tesla Museum in Belgrade including solar panels, models of laboratories and the Tesla coil, while the Tesla bust was loaned from the Serbian Embassy. The exhibition closes on 3 March.

At a formal dinner hosted on the eve of the exhibition's opening at the Grand Hofu Hotel, Mayor of Hofu City Yutaka Ikeda, Serbian Ambassador Nenad Glisic, Acting Director of the Nikola Tesla Museum Ivona Jevic and a local parliamentary representative in Yamaguchi Prefecture, Noriaki Shimada gave speeches.
