



On 24 March, the Consulate General in Frankfurt in collaboration with the Serbian Cultural Centre in Offenbach am Main and the parish of the Serbian Orthodox Church organized an event marking the 20th anniversary since the NATO aggression against Yugoslavia took place.

The [commemorative event](#) was held on the premises of the Serbian Cultural Centre in Offenbach am Main. The ceremony opened by Consul Branko Radovanovic included screening of video footage from 1999 and an exhibition called "78 days in 78 photos" authored by Andreja Lovic, while the sounds of civil defence sirens called for a minute of silence for all the people who lost their lives during the NATO bombing.

Lieutenant Dejan Cimbalevic recalled civilian and military victims of the bombing and the resolute response the Serbian army had given in the fight against the enemy, while he also underlined Serbia's determination to preserve its military neutrality.
