

Rome: Italian-Serbian film festival presented in parliament

The Italy-Serbia Film [Festival](#) was promoted in the Italian Parliament's Parliamentary Groups Hall on 16 September. The fourth edition of the Belgrade Italian-Serbian Film Festival will be held from September 23 to September 26 at the Film Archive Museum in Belgrade.

Ms. Tatjana Garcevic, Minister Counselor of the Embassy of Serbia, introduced participants to the RS Government Decree on instruments for incentives in the field audio-visual works in Serbia, providing good conditions for co-productions with Serbian partners, good practices, as well as activities undertaken by institutions in Serbia in order to attract foreign producers.
