

Tokyo: Remembering painter and sculptor Milan Tucovic

The Embassy in Tokyo, in cooperation with the Tokyo Steps Gallery, organized the commemoration of the late Serbian painter and sculptor Milan Tucovic (1965-2019) on November 7th.

Thanks to Japanese friends and fans of the artist response, Ambassador Nenad Glisic recalled Milan Tucovic's long-standing collaboration with Japan since the first exhibition of his works in Tokyo in 2013.
