

Tel Aviv: Aleksandar Nikolic becomes Honorary Consul in Beersheba

Aleksandar Nikolic was appointed Honorary Consul of Serbia in Beersheba at the formal ceremony of the Israeli Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The formal ceremony was attended by Leader of Israel Our Home Party and Former Defense Minister Avigdor Lieberman, Knesset MP Gary Koren, Director of the Balkan Region at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Dan Oryan, Dean of the Honorary Consular Corps Gad Propper, Honorary Consul of Serbia in Jerusalem Boris Krasny and others.
