There are various ways how to strengthen the relations in sphere of the Public Diplomacy. Katara is a master piece of architecture and a perfect combination of the new technology, urbanism, tradition and nature. I think it is one of the nicest objects in Qatar and this part of the world and your nation can be proud to have it. As the Cultural Village, it is a centre point for
