



First Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Serbia and Minister of Foreign Affairs Ivica Dacic attended today the ceremony of opening for traffic the remaining section of the Highway "9 January" connecting Banja Luka and Doboј.

Attending the ceremony as Envoy of the President of the Republic of Serbia Aleksandar Vucic, Minister Dacic said that he was pleased to take part in the ceremony and stressed that the Highway "9 January" was a deeply significant infrastructural project.
