



On his bilateral visit to Georgia, First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia Ivica Dacic met with Prime Minister of Georgia Mamuka Bakhtadze. In the friendly talks, the collocutors stressed the high convergence of views between the two countries on the crucial political and economic development paths.
