



First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia Ivica Dacic met today in Dar es Salaam with Minister of Foreign Affairs and East African Cooperation of the United Republic of Tanzania Palamagamba Kabudi.

Minister Dacic said that Serbia was committed to building best possible relations with Tanzania, based on friendship and cooperation established in the years when Tanzania gained independence.

Minister Dacic underlined education, pharmaceutical industry, tourism and agriculture as potential areas for cooperation.
