



First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia Ivo Dacic met today with Ambassador of Argentina to the Republic of Serbia Estanislao Angel Zawels, Ambassador of Brazil Eduardo Botelho Barbosa and Ambassador of Canada Kati Csaba who, in the framework of the Lima Group, informed him of the mutual position and active approach of their countries with regard to the crisis in Venezuela.
