



Minister of Foreign Affairs Ivan Mrkic left for New York as a member of the delegation headed by President of the Republic of Serbia Tomislav Nikolic.

President Nikolic will speak in the UN General Assembly debate entitled „Role of the international criminal justice in reconciliation“.

As stated by the President Press Service, President Nikolic will have bilateral meetings with the UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon and also with Chairman of BiH Presidency Nebojsa Radmanovic.

A public debate on the work of international criminal tribunals, scheduled by President of the UN General Assembly Vuk Jeremic, will be held at the UN General Assembly on East River on Wednesday; so far, more than 40 UN member states have applied to participate.
